Nettesheim named new executive director

Please join us in welcoming Joe Nettesheim as TYME OUT's new executive director. Joe comes to us from St. Margaret Mary parish where he served as director of lifelong faith formation. He steps into the role recently vacated by Ben Brzeski, who served as executive director of TYME OUT for the last seven years.



“Through a process that included more than 20 applicants, conversations with ten outstanding candidates, and substantive interviews with four of those individuals, the search committee unanimously agreed to extend an offer to Joe,” said TYME OUT Board President Jerry DeMers. “He not only has a rich history of prior interaction with and commitment to TYME OUT, but he also has the deep faith and strong leadership to guide this ministry for years to come.”

At age 16, Joe took part in a confirmation retreat at TYME OUT, after which he became involved in the organization's peer ministry group, an experience he credits with his decision to pursue a theology degree. Over the years, he maintained a connection to TYME OUT, serving as staff spiritual director and back-up team retreat director. He also brought the parishes he served to TYME OUT for retreats.

Joe speaks of his deep affection for TYME OUT and credits the organization with helping inspire him toward a life of ministry. “My care and concern for and my commitment to the mission of TYME OUT is why I am excited about the opportunity to become its executive director,” he said.

With more than 20 years of ministry experience, Joe has served various parishes as director of youth ministry, director of adult and family ministry, and pastoral associate. He coordinated the Global Youth Mission for World Mission Ministries of the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and has been a director of Reach Out/Reach In, a summer service camp sponsored by the Archdiocese. In 1999, he received the Vatican II award for Service to the Missions.

Outgoing Executive Director Ben Brzeski is also enthused about Joe leading TYME OUT into its next chapter. “Joe brings a wealth of ministry experience, significant history with TYME OUT, and a passion for serving youth,” he said. “I believe he will serve this ministry very well, and that the prayerful discernment and clear-eyed assessment of TYME OUT's needs by the search committee will lead to a strong future for TYME OUT.”

In addition to his bachelor's degrees in theology and writing-intensive English from Marquette University and master's degree in religious studies from Cardinal Stritch University, Nettesheim is currently pursuing a master's degree in dispute resolution at Marquette University. He is also a devoted father to Emma, 15, and Andrew, 11. †

World Youth Day (WYD) was initiated by Blessed Pope John Paul II in 1985 as a means of bringing young people together to celebrate their Catholic faith. It is held every year at the diocesan level and as a week-long international event every two to three years, always in a different location. This year's event will take place in Madrid, Spain, and TYME OUT is preparing 33 people to attend.

On July 16, the group of 22 youth and 11 adults gathered at TYME OUT for a WYD retreat where they prayed, played, and enjoyed fellowship in preparation for their



Aug. 11 departure. In addition to attending WYD festivities, the group will also visit the shrines of Avila, Fatima, and Santiago de Compostela and will learn more about the lives of Saint John of the Cross, St. Teresa of Avila, St. James, and Our Lady of Fatima.

TYME OUT has a great history of successfully leading international youth-oriented excursions, beginning with WYD in 2000. We led a contingent of 20 to the event in Rome, one of the last WYD events where Pope John Paul II was present. Most recently, TYME OUT was part of a group of 19 who traveled to WYD in Australia in 2008, where 750,000 Catholic youth joined in prayer and worship with Pope Benedict XVI.

Program summary: changing times

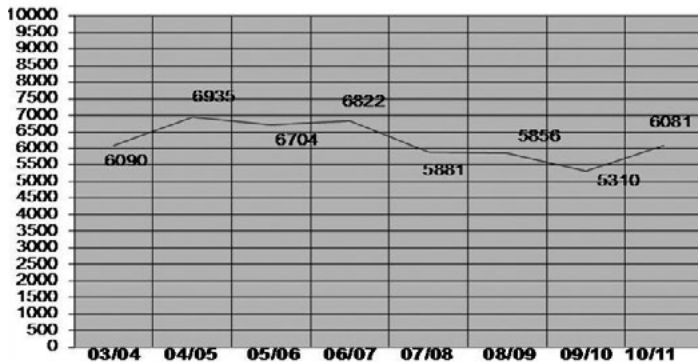
To remain a successful youth ministry organization, we have to be sure we are reaching youth where they are – which isn't necessarily where we might expect to find them. In 2010-11, TYME OUT offered services to parishes without available funds to come to TYME OUT by visiting and ministering to them in their own locations. We also rented our facility to organizations other than parish groups. These two approaches proved successful in reaching youth who otherwise would not have been touched by TYME OUT.

We served 623 additional people by attending off-site events in locations as diverse as Random Lake, Racine, Pewaukee, Franklin, Horicon, and Milwaukee. At these events we trained potential youth leaders of the parish and played games with junior high students to prepare them for Faith-a-thon. We created a new retreat themed on the simple things of life which can be forgotten so quickly in our fast-paced world. We took our Relationship retreat on the road and shared the wisdom of creating good, healthy relationships. We made an impact on some seventh and eighth graders by doing the first part of the impact retreat at their school and then bringing them to TYME OUT to complete it.

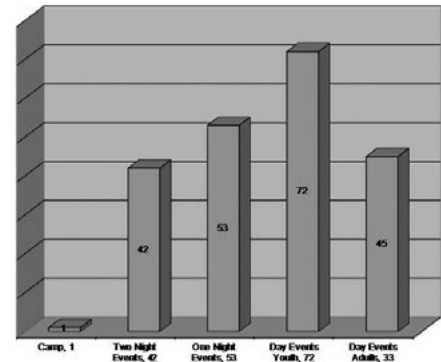
TYME OUT actively worked to increase the rental of our facility, and we succeeded. A variety of groups took advantage of our outstanding accommodations, with a total of 457 people attending events such as basketball, soccer, or baseball tournaments, or family reunions. Our new procedures for rentals were a tremendous help in ensuring that staff understand the process and can offer appropriate help to visiting groups.

Through a simple but necessary process of listening to our target demographic, TYME OUT has been able to serve 1,080 more youth and adults this year than otherwise would have been reached. We will continue going to where the needs are so that TYME OUT continues to be a viable part of ministry well into the future. †
